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1 the negative equity) was \$2,336.40, even though the true amount of negative equity was  
2 actually \$5,370.22.

3 10. Infiniti of Mission Viejo's improper disclosure of the negative equity fooled  
4 Plaintiff into believing that the Infiniti G37's lease contract contained less negative  
5 equity than it actually did. Had Plaintiff known about the true amount of negative  
6 equity she would not have leased the Infiniti G37. Infiniti of Mission Viejo falsified and  
7 failed to properly disclose the negative equity in order to trick Plaintiff into signing the  
8 lease contract and/or to obtain financing for a transaction that otherwise would not  
9 have been financed.  
10

11 11. Consistent with Plaintiff's experience, Infiniti of Mission Viejo has a  
12 pattern and practice of illegally rolling undisclosed negative equity from trade-in  
13 vehicles into the leases of new vehicles without properly disclosing the true amounts of  
14 such negative equity.  
15

16 FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

17 Violation of Vehicle Leasing Act

18 12. Plaintiff hereby incorporates by reference the allegations in Paragraphs 1  
19 through 11.

20 13. The lease contract for the Infiniti G37 is a lease contract under the VLA.

21 14. Infiniti of Mission Viejo is a "lessor" under the VLA.

22 15. Plaintiff is a "lessee" under the VLA.

23 16. The Infiniti G37 is a "motor vehicle" under the VLA.

24 17. Civil Code Section 2985.8(c)(2)(F) requires that all motor vehicle lease  
25 contracts disclose in a section titled "Itemization of Gross Capitalized Cost" the true  
26 amount of any outstanding prior credit or lease balance.  
27  
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1 it does not have or involve, or which are prohibited by law; (2) representing that the  
2 subject of a transaction has been supplied in accordance with a previous representation  
3 when it has not; and (3) representing that the consumer will receive a rebate, discount,  
4 or other economic benefit, if the earning of the benefit is contingent on an event to occur  
5 subsequent to the consummation of the transaction. The CLRA also prohibits omissions  
6 where there exists an independent legal requirement to make a statement or disclosure.  
7

8         26. Infiniti of Mission Viejo violated the CLRA by misrepresenting by failing to  
9 properly disclose the negative equity involved in Plaintiff's lease contract for the Infiniti  
10 G37.

11         27. Plaintiff is concurrently serving Infiniti of Mission Viejo with a CLRA  
12 notification and demand letter via regular mail and certified mail, return receipt  
13 requested. The notice letter sets forth the relevant facts, notifies Infiniti of Mission  
14 Viejo of its CLRA violations, and requests that Infiniti of Mission Viejo promptly remedy  
15 those violations.  
16

17         28. Under the CLRA, a plaintiff may without prior notification file a complaint  
18 alleging violations of the CLRA that seeks injunctive relief only. Then, if the defendant  
19 does not remedy the CLRA violations within 30 days of notification, the plaintiff may  
20 amend her or his CLRA causes of action without leave of court to add claims for  
21 damages. Plaintiff will amend this complaint to add damages claims if Infiniti of  
22 Mission Viejo does not remedy its violations within the statutory period.  
23

24         29. Under the CLRA, Plaintiff is entitled to a permanent injunction  
25 prohibiting practices that violate the CLRA.

26         30. Infiniti of Mission Viejo has an illegal pattern and practice of  
27 misrepresenting and failing to properly disclose the amount of negative equity being  
28 rolled into consumers' lease transactions.



1 immoral, unscrupulous, unethical, and offensive, or causes substantial injury to  
2 consumers.

3 38. The above described unlawful, fraudulent, or unfair business acts and  
4 practices conducted by Infiniti of Mission Viejo continue to this day and present a threat  
5 to Plaintiff and the general public in that Infiniti of Mission Viejo has failed to publicly  
6 acknowledge the wrongfulness of its actions and provide full equitable injunctive and  
7 monetary relief as required by law.

9 39. Pursuant to California Business & Professions Code Section 17203,  
10 Plaintiff is entitled to and seeks a permanent injunction from this Court requiring  
11 Infiniti of Mission Viejo to immediately cease such acts of unfair competition and  
12 enjoining Infiniti of Mission Viejo from continuing to conduct business via the unlawful,  
13 fraudulent, and/or unfair business acts and practices set forth in this Complaint and  
14 from failing to fully disclose the true nature of its misrepresentations, and ordering  
15 Infiniti of Mission Viejo to engage in a corrective notice and advertising campaign.

17 PRAYER FOR RELIEF

18 Plaintiff prays for judgment as follows as appropriate for the particular causes of  
19 action:

- 20 1. For permanent injunctive relief as permitted under the VLA, the CLRA,  
21 and Business & Professions Code Section 17203;
- 22 2. For the declaratory and/or equitable relief under the VLA, the CLRA, and  
23 Business & Professions Code Section 17203;
- 24 3. For rescission of Plaintiff's \$26,223.34 lease contract for the Infiniti G37,  
25 and restitution of all amounts that Plaintiff has paid towards the Infiniti  
26 G37's lease;  
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
